2019 Update:

As you can imagine planning for 2019 is well underway in the midst of our end of year celebrations. I wanted to share with you all some of the exciting changes that are coming up.

Firstly, I would like to congratulate Mrs Jeffries on being appointed as an Instructional Leader for some of the small schools in our District. Mrs Jeffries will be sharing her expertise with these schools over the next couple of years and we wish her all the very best in her leadership role.

I would also like to thank Mrs Ryan for her years of dedicated service to Mulyan Public School. She is a truly amazing teacher who has touched many lives. After six months Long Service Leave Mrs Ryan will not be returning to us in 2019. She is enjoying retirement



too much. We will organise an appropriate celebration for her early next year. She will be sorely missed by staff and students!

Mrs Johnson will also not be joining us in 2019. Mrs Johnson has accepted an offer to work at Holmwood Public School. I would like to thank Mrs Johnson for her hard work and dedication to our school over many years and wish her the very best in her new teaching adventure.

So, our teaching teams for 2019 will be quite different. The exact classes that will be taken by each teacher is still not set in concrete but our teams are established.

The K-2 team will be led by Mrs Statham supported by Mrs Baratto, Mrs Cameron and Mrs Keefe (both on Kinder) and a replacement for Mrs Ryan is yet to be decided. Mrs Beecher will continue to work with our Infants team as an Instructional Leader. Mrs Lauren Wilson will be working with Mrs Beecher to take over and run the 'Club House' which will still be operating to support students.

Stage 2 (Years 3 & 4) will be led by Mrs Murray. She will be supported by Mrs Smith, Mrs Apps and Mrs Montgomery. They will be supported by Mrs Jones our Instructional Leader who works on Mondays.

Stage 3 (Years 5 & 6) will be led by Mrs Cummings. She will be supported by Mrs Reeves, Mrs Wilson and Mrs Beale.

The Primary Team will be supported by Mrs Stockley and Mrs Grainger who offer small support classes and one on one sessions for students with learning difficulties. This allows for the continuation of support from the 'Club House' and has been a very successful model in 2018. Mr Beale will also continue fulltime on this support team working with our Aboriginal students to ensure that they have excellent skills in Literacy and Maths. Our SLSO team will also continue with us in their wide variety of roles.

Mr Ryan will return to us fulltime to teach PE and Sport again in 2019 and Mrs Bryant will continue in the Library. Her role will also expand to include a role leading enrichment activities for all students K-6. These activities will be based on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) and will be project based learning team taught with classroom teachers so everyone is learning together. Some of the topics offered will be Robotics, Coding and Green screen filming. I am hoping to continue with, and if possible, expand our music enrichment offerings in 2019.

As a teaching team we are all very excited about the changes coming in 2019 and look forward to the challenges that change inevitably brings. Always at the centre of what we do is our students and supporting their learning everyday.

Intensive Swimming

Intensive Swimming has now finished and the children that participated certainly came a long way with their swimming skills. We hope that they now get lots of opportunities to perfect and improve on these skills over the Summer. Swimming is such a vital skill for all children and we are so lucky to have this opportunity for our students. Thanks to Miss Noal and Mrs Waters for accompanying the Primary students and to Mrs Thornett, Mr Ryan and Mrs Murray for accompanying our Year 2 Intensive Swimmers.
