In August each year, we are required to complete the National Consistent Collection of Data on students with a disability. This means that all schools add to a national database by listing the number of school students they teach who are receiving an adjustment or 'help' due to disability, and what level of adjustment that is. The collection of this data each year ensures that all students receive the help they require and allows for government to better understand and resource schools so they can provide for all students.

The information collected includes what year the child is in, what level of adjustment they receive and what broad disability category they fall into. We have a number of students at our school that we add to the database each year.
