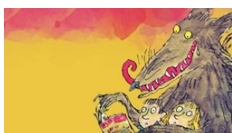
STAGE 1 EXCURSION to BATHURST

RETURN: 5pm in the Lachlan St bus bay at the front of the school.

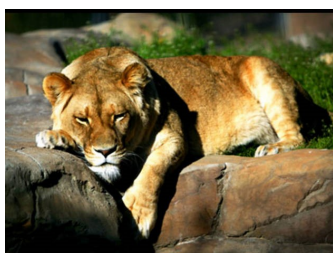
TRANSPORT: We have two 61 seat coaches from the Cowra Bus Service.

COST: \$50 per student. Family discount: First ticket is \$50, second ticket \$45 and third ticket \$40. We have given a lot of notice so that families can pay off the cost through the office, similar to a layby. A non-refundable \$10 deposit is required when the note is returned.
