Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that our Primary parents aren't feeling too lonely this morning as many of the students set off on their adventure. Stage 3 will spend the next three days exploring Sydney and Stage 2 will be having a blast with activities at Lake Burrendong Sport and Recreation Camp. Thank you to all of our families for helping to make this happen and to our teachers for giving up their time to allow students the chance to experience an overnight excursion. I look forward to hearing the stories of the fun everyone had when they get back. If you child was unable to go for any reason alternate activities are still happening at school while the majority of students are away.

This week and next week all students in Year 2 to Year 6 will be undergoing Maths and Reading testing. This is nothing to be concerned about and does not require anything special from families. The testing is run online by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) and will be run across the two weeks in Library time. The tests are designed to give myself and the leadership team some big picture results so that we can ensure that our school is committing funding to support student learning in the areas of most need. The results will also be used by classroom teachers this year and next year to plan for individual student learning. Testing will be ongoing each year in October and will be adjusted so that no student is completing a test that is not in line with fairly assessing their skills. If you have any questions please feel free to ring me and ask. This is not about wide spread reporting but about



helping us to better cater for every student's learning needs.

Please don't forget that Mr Lewis Beale, our Aboriginal Community Liaison Officer, is having meet & greet sessions for the parents and carers of our Aboriginal students this Thursday. They will be held at 2pm and 6pm in the VTS. Please come along and have a chat to Lew so that we can work together to support each and every one of our children.
